## **Duffer's Classic Tournament Rules**

Entry Fee: \$25 – Payable to Dale Rogers – This is in addition to any money paid to Garth.

Entry Fee includes daily prizes for Closet to the Pin and Longest Drive.

Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and last place teams. Skins will be calculated for each hole. A skin will be awarded on every hole that has a single low score. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of Dale Rogers / Mike Steiner.

**Online Scoring:** We will be using online scoring for all players. The online scoring site can be accessed at <a href="http://www.duffersclassic.com/">http://www.duffersclassic.com/</a> under the Saturday Tournament menu item. Please also keep a paper scorecard in the event of technical difficulties.

Tournament Round will be the Saturday Morning Round only. Each tournament player should have a first and last name legibly printed on the scorecard. The name should match the name on the online scoring site.

Scorecards should be given to Dale Rogers or Mike Steiner immediately after the Saturday Morning round. Lost scorecards may result in a forfeited entry or entries if there are technical difficulties. No entry fees will be refunded.

G-Funk Productions shall have the final authority to resolve any and all tournament disputes.

Two man teams will be chosen using a computerized random draw process (Blind Draw). If there are an uneven number of players, a player will be chosen at random from the list of players to fill out the final team. The player chosen will then play for two teams in the tournament.

Scores will be calculated using the Callaway Handicap Scoring System.

Team scores will be calculated by adding the Individual Callaway Scores for each team member.

## **Tiebreaking Procedure**

Scorecards will be used to break ties for 1<sup>st</sup> and last place teams. Hole by hole card matching will be used starting at the first hole.

## First Place / Last Place

Card matching will continue hole by hole starting at the first hole until a single team has the lowest (first place) / highest (last place) team score for a hole. If there are multiple teams involved in the tiebreaker, only teams that are tied for the lowest / highest score will continue. Multiple winners will be declared if there are still tied entries after the 18<sup>th</sup> hole.
